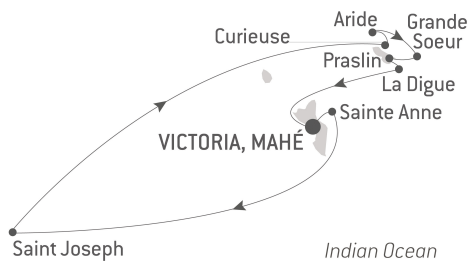

In **Praslin**, don't miss the chance to visit the **Vallée de Mai Nature Reserve**. There you will find **sea coconuts**, gigantic endemic fruits with a very evocative shape, nicknamed the "love nut".

Palm trees, granite rock, **white sand and crystal-clear water** then await you on **Grande Sœur** and **La Digue**. The beaches on these two stunning islands are each more beautiful than the next, guaranteeing moments of relaxation that will live up to your fantasies of the Seychelles.
